*These are intermediate-level courses for ABB employees and distributors authorized to sell the listed products*

### Mebane 101:

- molded case circuit breakers
- NEMA starters
- lighting contactors
- dry-type transformers
- modular metering
- load centers with residential breakers
- panelboards.

This class focuses on small project take-offs and pricing, with hands-on practice with empower quote software and real product samples.

#### Prerequisites:

- At least 3 months experience in electrical component sales
- At least 2 hours experience using Empower software to quote small jobs.

### Mebane 102

At the end of the course, the student will be familiar with the products listed below, be able to read electrical drawings and schedules of these products and know how to enter these products into empower for a quote.

- switchboards
- motor control centers
- busway

There will be hands-on practice with empower quote software and real equipment samples.

#### Prerequisites:

- Completion of Mebane 101, or
- ability to handle panelboard quotes through 1200A on Empower without assistance.

***Safety Notes:***

***Steel toed safety shoes are required*** for walking through the shop areas. If you do not have safety shoes ABB can provide you with toe covers for your visit, but your shoes must cover your entire foot.

***Long pants are required*** in the Fabrication department. Long Skirts that completely cover legs and ankles with no splits would be acceptable.
