With reference to the captioned subject, we would like to inform you that the Company has received an order from the Office of the Principal Commissioner of Customs, Bengaluru imposing a redemption fine of 3,00,00,000/- (INR Three Crores only) and penalty of 2,70,24,078/- (INR Two Crores Seventy Lakhs Twenty Four Thousand and Seventy Eight only) under the Section 125 and Section 114A of the Customs Act, 1962 respectively in relation to wrong availment of benefit under Sl. No13 of Notification no. 57/2017-Customs dated 30.06.2017.

Based on the Company's assessment, an appeal will be filed and the Company is hopeful of a favorable outcome at the appellate level and does not reasonably expect the said Order to have any material impact on the Company.
