Course goal

The goal of this course is to teach students to maintain and operate ACS880-04/07 drives.

- Do basic maintenance for ACS880-04 and ACS880-07 drives.

- ACS880-04 Location and basic maintenance;
- ACS880-07 Location and basic maintenance;
- ACS880-07 service and operation;
- ACS880-07 module replacements.

Participant profile

This course is intended for electricians, technicians, and engineers who maintain, operate and service ACS880-04 and ACS880-07 drives.

Course type and methods

This is a classroom course with hands-on lab activities supported by an instructor. This course contains hands-on ACS880 exercises.

Prerequisites

Participants should have secondary specialized or higher technical education and/or experience in the electrical industry.

Duration

The duration is 2 days (16 hours: 6 hours – theoretical part, 10 hours – practical part).
